### Research **ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS** for your commute

- 50% subsidy on MBTA passes (Harvard program)
- Longwood T Party—put your parking space on hold for three months and try riding the train
- MASCO shuttles—take a free shuttle to work (<http://www.masco.org/transit/ptsWelcome.htm>)
- CommuteFit—earn prizes by walking, biking or jogging to work!
- Emergency Ride Home- get a free taxi ride or rental car to get home quickly in the event of an emergency (for commuters who don't drive alone)

- Register your bike with HUPD and park in the secure bike cages
- Bike route from Cambridge to LMA

### Sign up for **ZIPCAR**, a car-sharing service
